

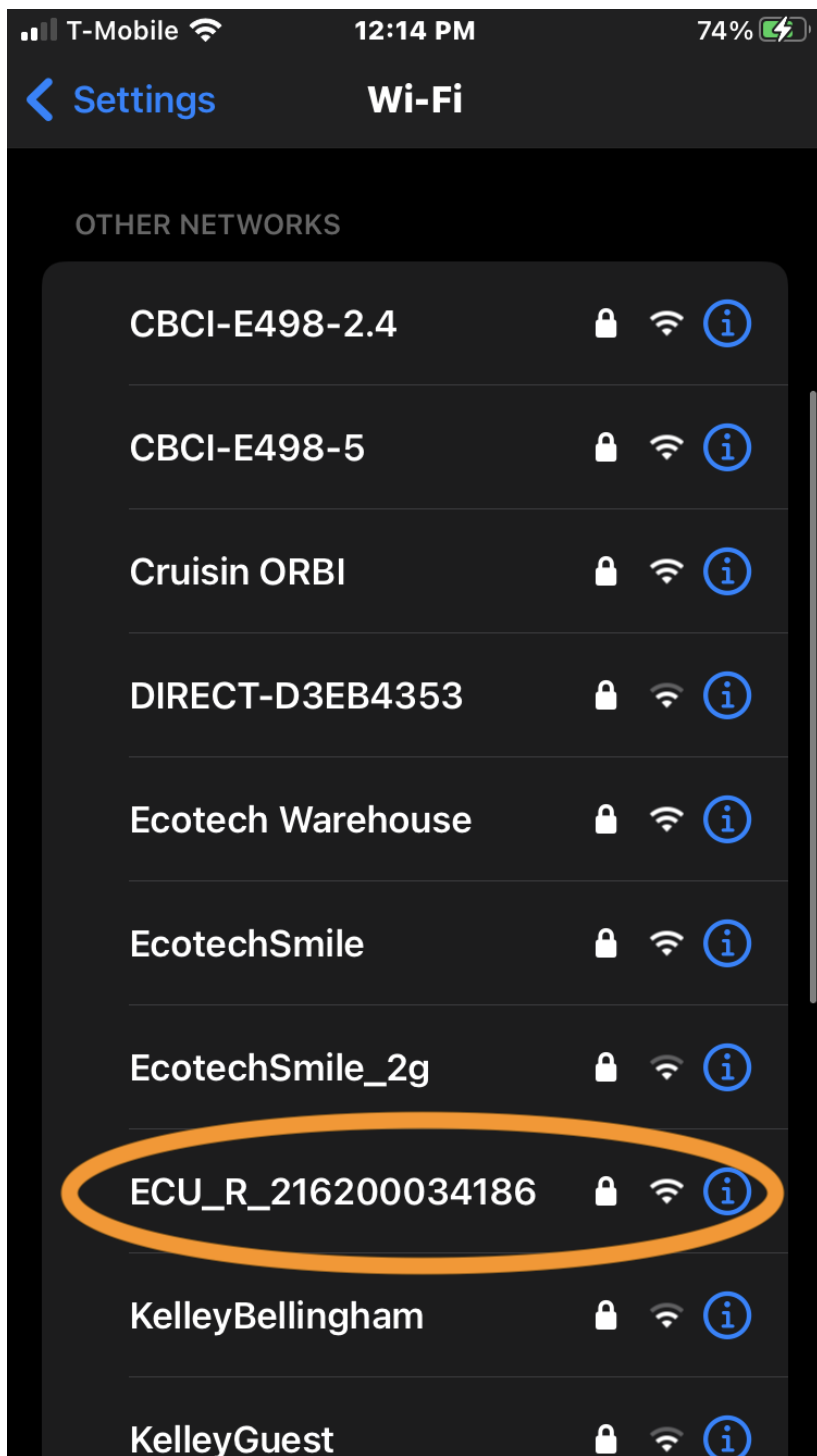
AP Systems Reconnection Instructions



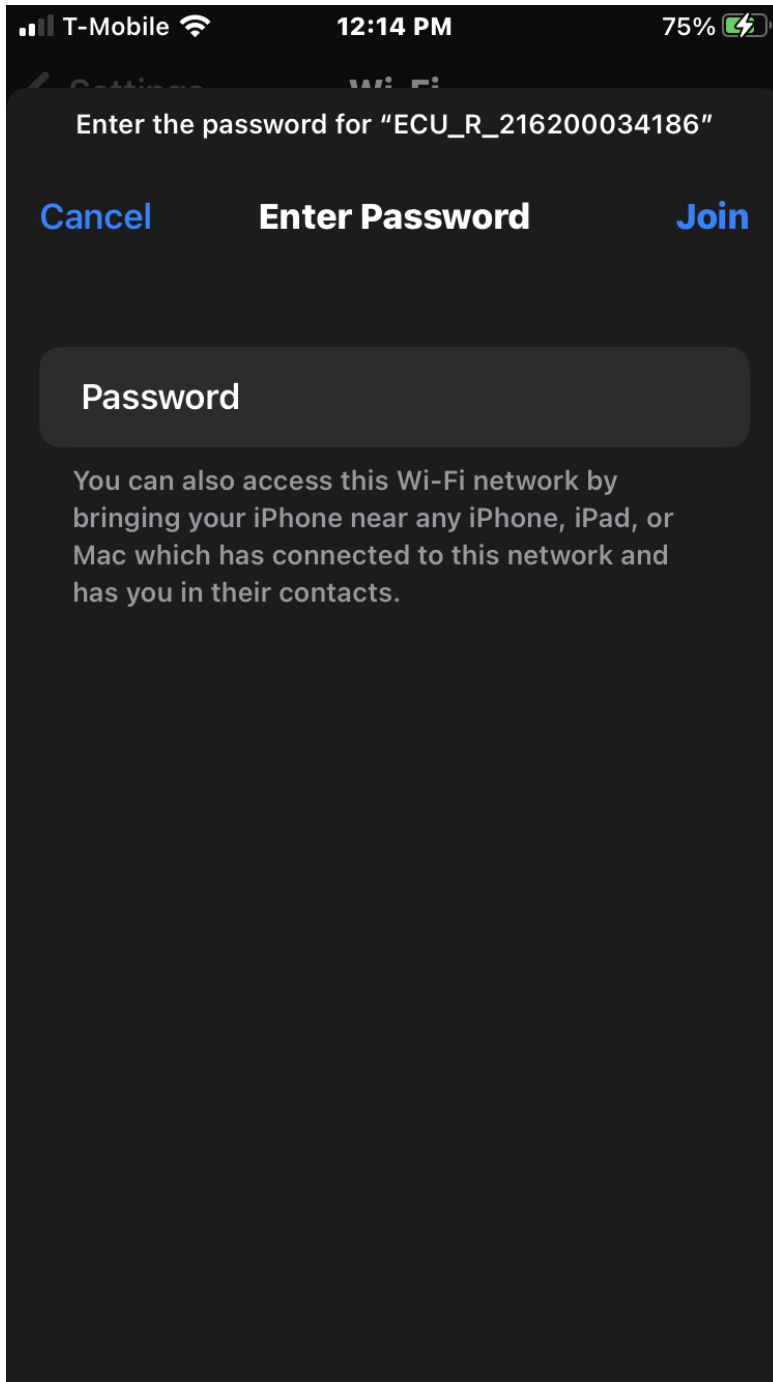
1. Locate your AP systems ECU unit and be sure it's plugged in and has power. Press the "AP" button found on the side. *Note: It normally takes several minutes for the WiFi network to appear in step #2.*



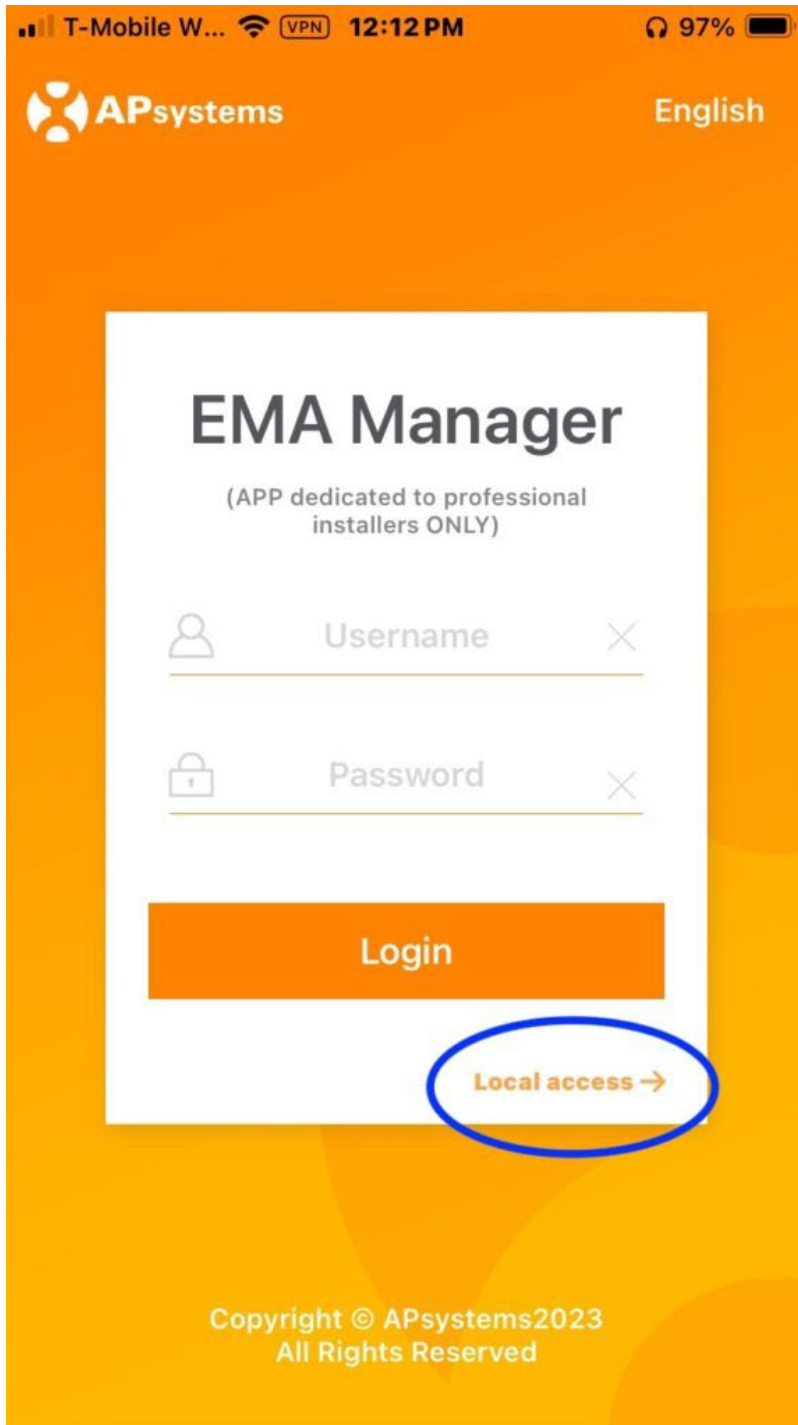
2. On your smartphone or tablet, go to your WiFi settings, and select the network named "ECU_#####" that appears after a few minutes.



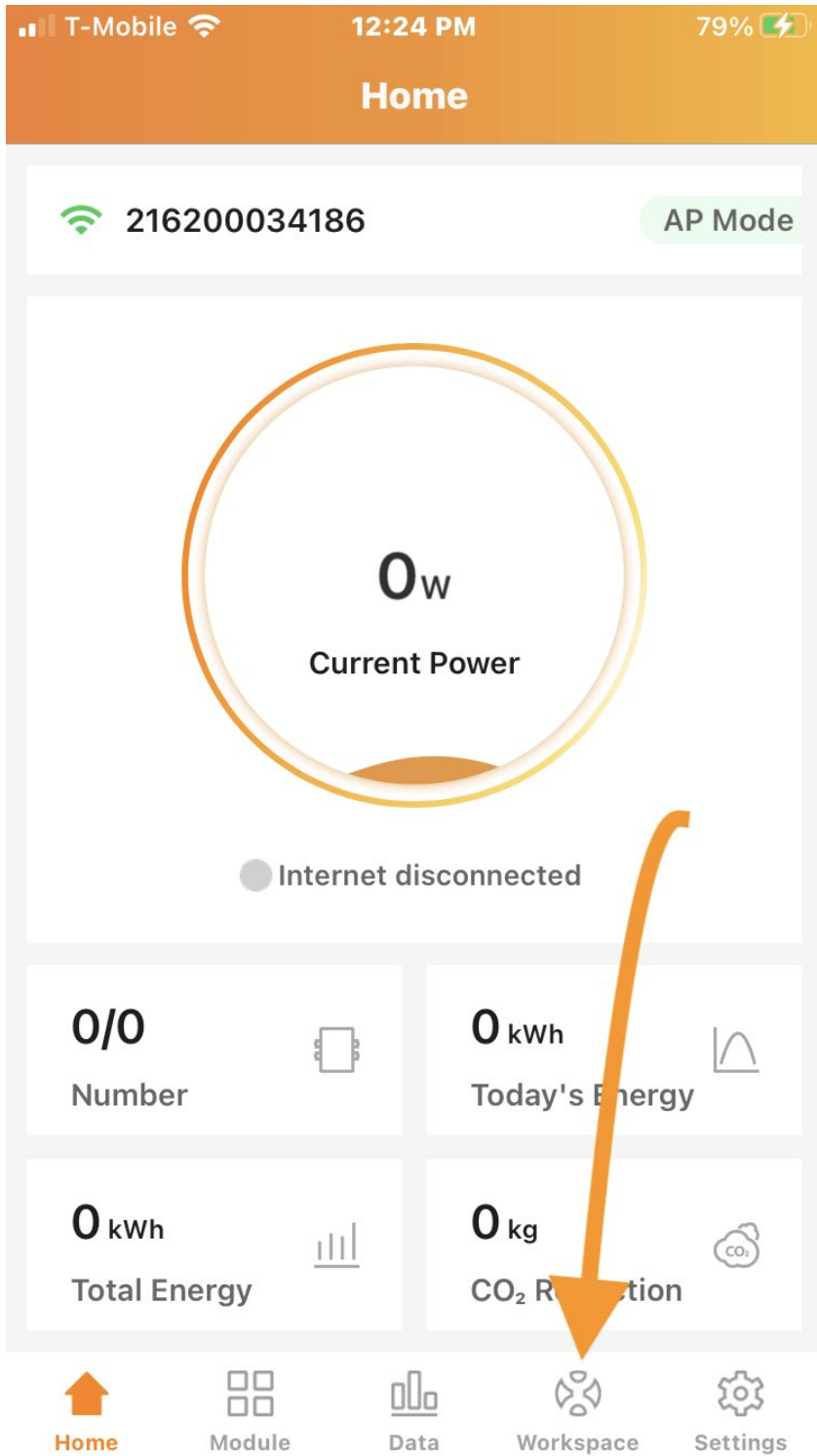
3. Enter the password "88888888" (ie. eight 8's)



4. Open the **“EMA Manager App”**, and be sure to select **“Local access”** to connect directly to your ECU.



5. From the homescreen, note the “Internet Disconnected” status. Select “Workspace” at the bottom.



6. Select "ECU Network Settings" from the Workspace menu

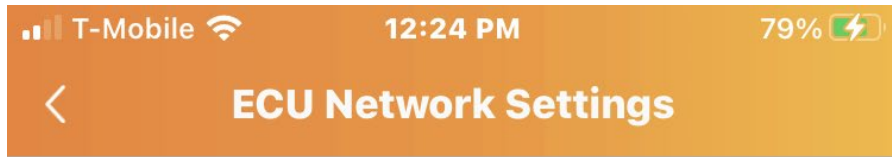

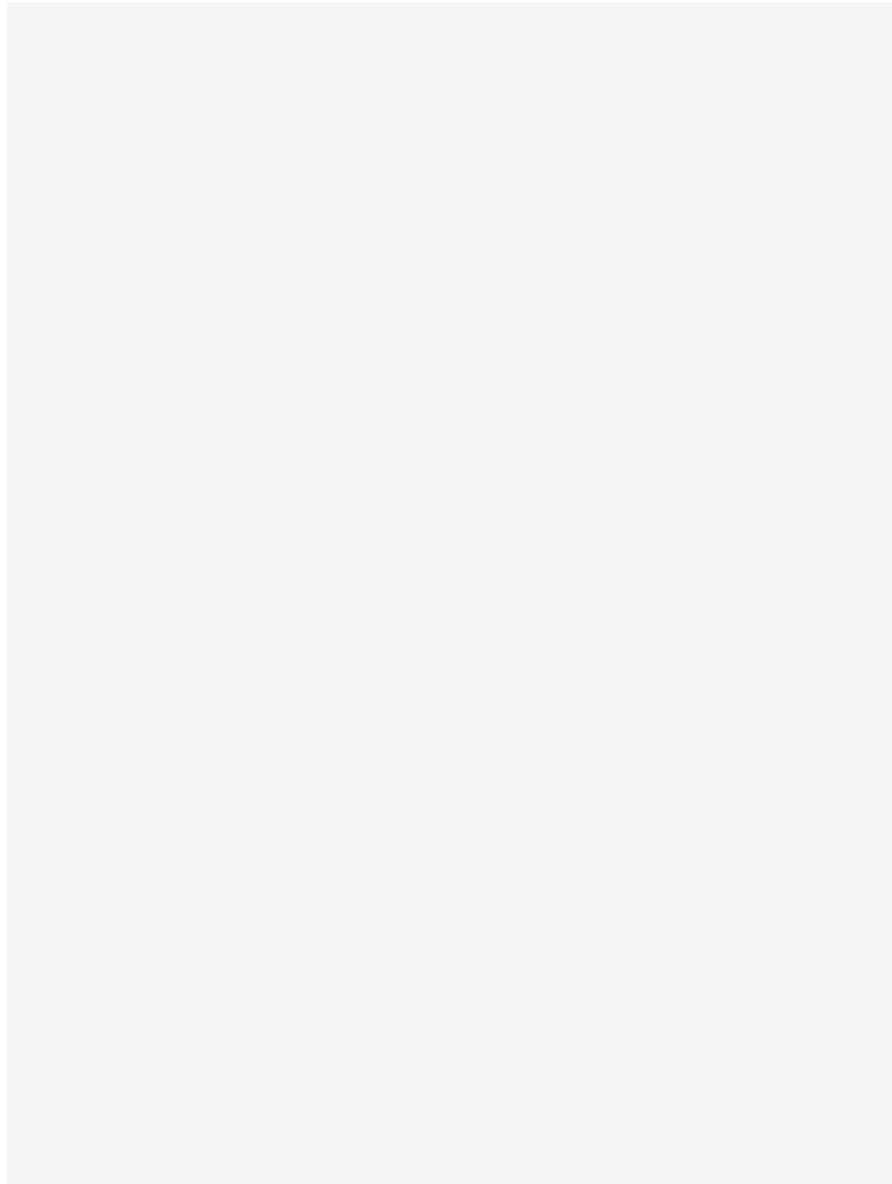

7. Select "WLAN Settings" to choose your Wi-Fi network

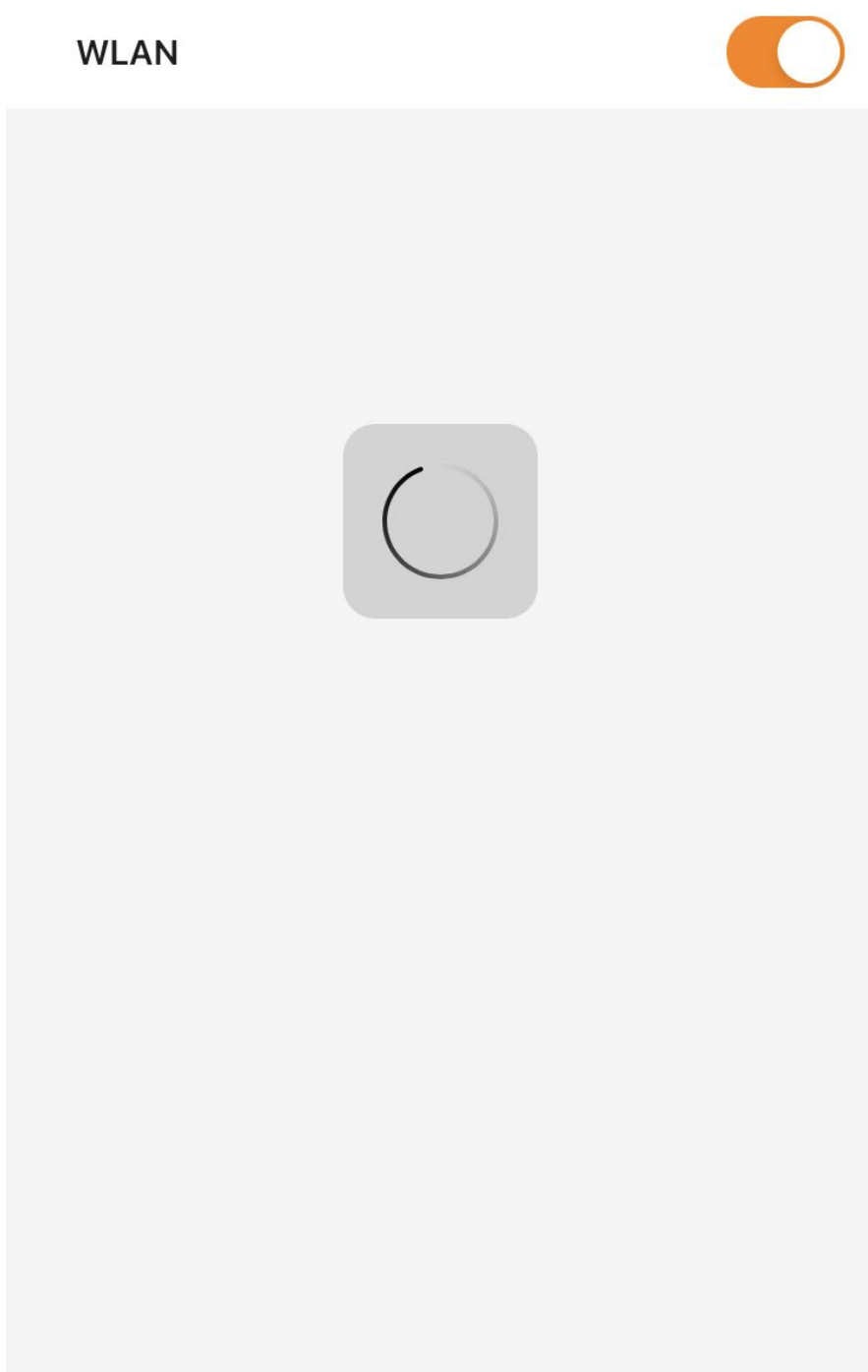

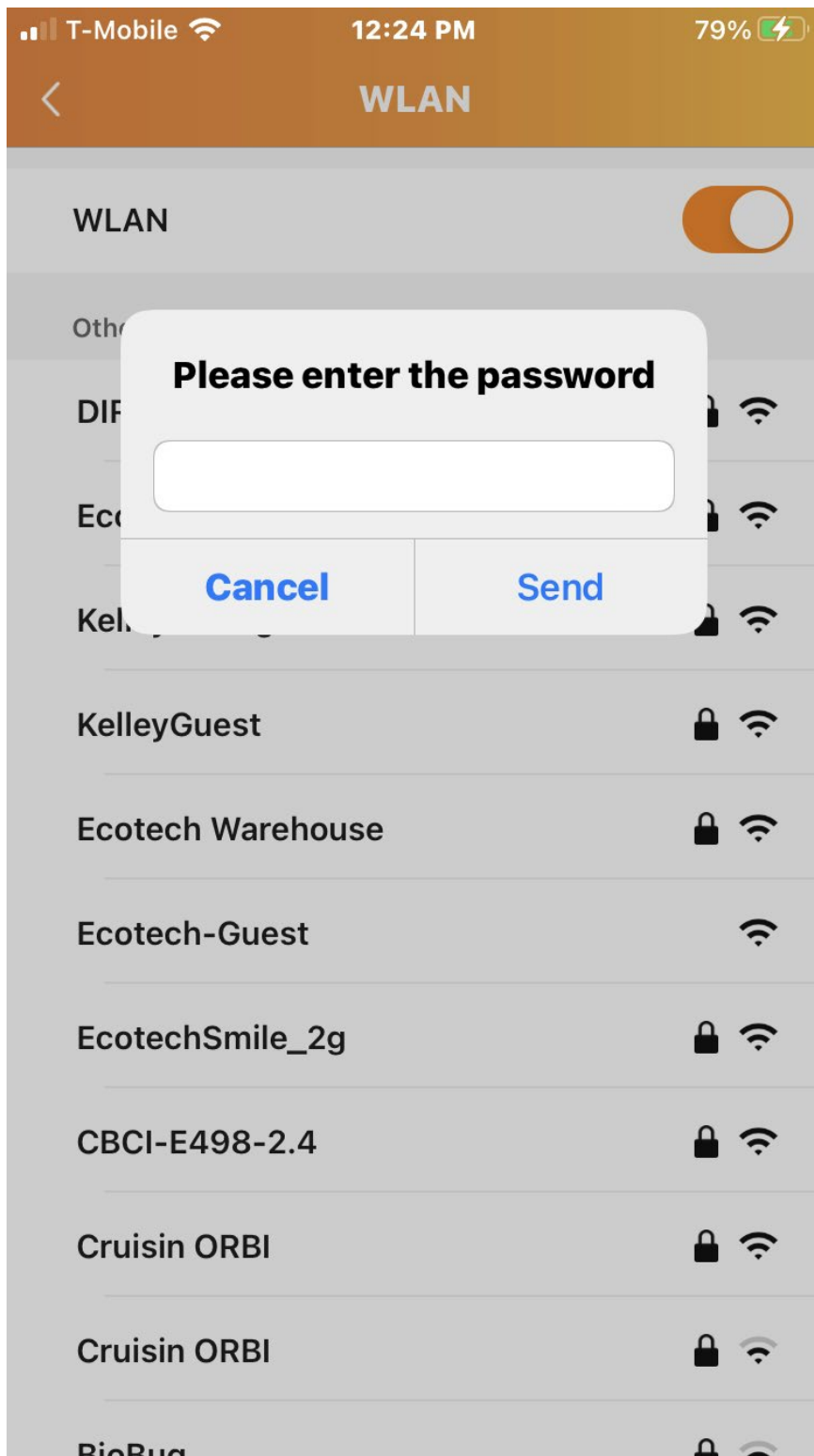
